In honor of the 250th birthday of our country, I wanted to share the words of a song I first heard as a child. Old Blue Eyes (Frank Sinatra) sang it in a ten-minute short film called "The House I Live In." The short film came out in 1945, and it was meant to oppose the anti-Semitism that occurred at the end of World War II.

Earl Hawley Robinson—a member of the Communist Party who was blacklisted by Sen. Joe McCarthy during the Red Scare of the 1950s—wrote the music for this American Anthem.

Abel Meeropol wrote the words. Abel was also a member of the American Communist Party; he and his wife adopted Michael and Robert Rosenberg after their parents Julius and Ethel Rosenberg were executed for espionage on June 19, 1953.

**What is America to me--a name, a map, or a flag I see...**

**A certain word, democracy--What is America to me?**

**The house I live in...a plot of earth, a street,**

**The grocer and the butcher and the people that I meet**

**The children in the playground the faces that I see**

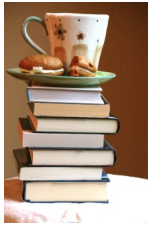
